- **I.D. Requirement:** ALL athletes participating in AAU Boys' Basketball licensed events (age-based or grade-based) must have one (1) of the following forms of I.D. for roster check-in: an unexpired passport, unexpired driver's license, an unexpired Department of Motor Vehicles I.D. card issued within the last three (3) years, a Military Dependent I.D., SportsAge I.D., or National Sports I.D.
- **Grade-Based Documents:** Along with one of the above forms of I.D., grade-based athletes must also present either a photocopy of their report card or progress report, which shows name, grade, and school, or confirmation of grade level from a school administrator (guidance counselor, principal, dean, etc.) on official school letterhead.
- Roster check-in will be conducted with original documents – no copies. All athletes must be present during check-in to verify their identity.
- The 2019 Georgia AAU District Boys' Basketball Age and Grade-based State Championships are for Georgia teams **ONLY**. All teams that participate in their respective State Championship have the opportunity to qualify for AAU Nationals.
- Each team is guaranteed a three (3) game minimum. The third (3rd) game could be in either pool play or single-elimination bracket play.
- The team on the left side of the pool play schedule/top of the bracket play schedule will be the home team and **MUST** wear light colored jerseys; the team on the right side of the pool play schedule/bottom of the bracket play schedule is the guest/visitor and **MUST** wear black/dark colored jerseys.
- Coaches and bench personnel **MUST** adhere to the AAU dress code: collared shirt, slacks, long khaki pants, and closed-toed shoes; no hats, no jeans, no shorts, no sweatpants, no t-shirts, nor open-toed shoes. Non-compliance can disallow coaches from sitting on the bench during their scheduled games.
- This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U.S., Inc.
- All participants must have a current AAU membership.
- AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event.
- **Be Prepared:** Adult and non-athlete memberships are no longer instant. Due to background screenings, please allow up to 10 days for membership to be processed.
- AAU youth athlete membership must be obtained before the competition begins, except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connection. Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU website [www.ausports.org](http://www.ausports.org) to obtain their membership.
